#### The Other Side

If you try to hang on to your life, you will lose it. But if you give up your life for my sake, you will save it. – Matthew 16:25

When I knew Susan, she had everything going for her: good grades, good looks, good job. Then she was in a car accident and was never the same.

I never quite understood what happened, but the drugs the doctors used to save her life apparently caused her to gain a huge amount of weight. She ballooned to two hundred and plenty pounds and lost most of her friends. Those who didn't know her just assumed she was overeating. Trouble was, Susan gained weight even when she didn't eat.

"Now I know," she once told me, "how it feels to be on the other side of the fence, to feel that you're a nobody because you don't look like the girls on Cosmo."

I later went away to college and didn't see Susan for about four years. One day after graduation I was in her area and decided to stop by. She was as big as ever......but she also wore a smile that indicated she wasn't as self-conscious about her weight.

"All my life," she said, "I was programmed to think success. I had it all. And I couldn't understand why other people weren't as together as me, you know? It was like I was the yardstick, and they didn't measure up. And God may have been somewhere out there, but I didn't need him because I was doing fine on my own.

"But now I understand – that I didn't understand anything before. The needs and hurts of others? Didn't see them. Never noticed because I was all that mattered. That all changed when I became the Sumo Lady. You look like this, it's hard to have much pride.

"Now? I'm not so full of myself," she continued. "And when there's less of me, there's more room for God. The amazing thing? It's easier now to help others. To really care. To risk everything for God.

"The ironic thing?" she asked. She paused for a moment and looked down. And then she came up smiling. "The irony is, I thank God for the accident. It took the car to lose myself. But that was really nothing. I lost me, but I found something more important that can never be taken away."




